## Case Study Bart's Health NHST

YHEC developed an economic model to quantify the potential benefits of developing a specialist Cardiovascular Centre at Bart's Health NHST, as part of an Outline Business Case (OBC). Data on activity, length of stay, patient mortality and potential benefits of specialisation were analysed to estimate the impact of various options for a specialist Cardiovascular Centre. Modelling indicated scope for significant benefits for the chosen option in terms of reduced patient mortality, as well as efficiency savings through reductions in length of hospital stay. The OBC was approved by NHS England in 2014 and Bart's Heart Centre at St Bartholomew's hospital is now open.
